



# Paradise Hills Ranch Lumby, BC 2009 Clinic/Camp Info



**Times:** **Please arrive the day before your clinic starts between 9:00 am and 5:00 pm as there will be an orientation at 7:00 p.m.** For example, if your clinic starts on July 21, then you need to arrive on the 20<sup>th</sup>. If you arrive earlier than this, you must make arrangements for accommodations for you and your horse to stay offsite. Start time will be 9:00 am on all days. Approximate end time will be between 4:00 and 5:00 pm. There will be a lunch break for about an hour. Lunch will be provided for riders. A charge of \$10 for spectators.

**Focus Camp:** **Nothing Beats Pure Focus** - Do you want to work on flying leads, liberty, lateral movements, etc. or anything specific? Come and get personal instruction from Larry in the morning and have an opportunity to apply your skills in the afternoon in Mother Nature's arena.

**Foundation Horses:** A good start isn't something...It's everything! This is the study of bringing a horse from Level 1 through to Level 3. Paradise Hills Ranch has over 90 head of horses from 3 year old and up, all sizes, some more advanced than others.

**Facilities:** **Lumby** - 648 Creighton Valley Road, Lumby, BC. Lumby is located approx. 15 kms east of Vernon on Highway 6. Continue on Hwy 6 through Lumby approx. 1 km, turn **right** at the cemetery (on left) onto Creighton Valley Road, and go 6.5 kms to 648 on your right. Proceed up gravel road 1.5 km.

There is a 100' x 200' outdoor arena and a 110' x 240' indoor arena, Savvy circle, round pens, ponds, creek, challenge course, creative obstacles, playground, 500+ acres of riding meadows and unlimited trails (border Crown Land). Glorious mountain vistas and lush pastures complete the picture. The ranch is only 7 minutes from Lumby and the area offers many lakes for swimming, fishing, hiking, boating or just relaxing so bring your bathing suit.

**Stabling /Feed:** **Course fees include feed, pen for one horse.** Individual outdoor pens are provided. Feed is a high quality alfalfa/timothy hay and grain. Hay must be fed in the designated spot and not in pens, as it causes a slippery condition when wet. Water buckets will be provided.

**Tack:** All riders are responsible for their own tack. Please bring all your PNH equipment that you have and put some identification on all of it. PNH Equipment is not required however will be available for purchase on site if needed.

**Dogs:** **Absolutely No dogs allowed.** If you bring your dog, you will be asked to kennel your dog off-site for the duration of the clinic. **Strictly enforced.**

## **Accommodations Options:**

Cozy cabins are available on the ranch and each cabin sleeps four people in two sets of bunk beds. Each bed includes linen, pillow, and European-style comforters. Space is available for RV's or campers (no hookups or showers yet) or students may arrange their own accommodations at a nearby motel or camping area. Unless the lodge is finished, students can shower at a nearby campground. **Lunch is included in course fee plus a special BBQ on the last night.** We have campfires and sing-a-longs so bring an instrument if you play one!
